

# BELGRADE SIGHTSEEING TOUR (up to 3 hours)

## WALKING TOUR

**THE BELGRADE FORTRESS** is located on a hill overlooking the confluence of Sava River and the Danube. Over the centuries of sieges, battles and conquests, the fortress was repeatedly razed to the ground, rebuilt and restructured. The Belgrade Fortress consists of Upper Town, Lower Town and Kalemegdan Park.

**KNEZ MIHAILOVA STREET** the main part of the pedestrian area between Terazije and Kalemegdan Park. Called after Prince Mihailo Obrenovic.

**PRINCESS LJUBICA'S RESIDENCE** built in 1829 for the family of Prince Milos Obrenovic, and there lived his wife Ljubica and sons Milan and Mihailo. Today it houses a part of the ethnographic exhibition.

**BELGRADE CATHEDRAL** the church built in 1845 dedicated to Archangels Michail & Gabriel, with tombs of some members of the Obrenović dynasty.

**THE SEAT OF THE SERBIAN PATRIARCH** across the street of the Cathedral with Ecclesiastical Museum. **"?" RESTAURANT** built in 1825 got this unusual name as its last owner could not recall any better.

**KOSANČIĆEV VENAC** paved in cobbled stones having the look of the town from the first half of the 19th century.

**STUDENTSKI TRG** square and park with several buildings of Belgrade University, Ethnographic Museum and Kolarčev narodni univerzitet.

**REPUBLIC SQUARE** with the National Theatre, National Museum and the equestrian statue of Prince Mihail Obrenović.

**TERAZIJE** the main square called after the water level of the towers parts of the Turkish aqueduct in existence there in the 18th century.
